



Now Accepting Applications for City of Tomball Boards and Commissions



The City of Tomball is accepting applications for potential appointments in the current year. Membership on boards or commissions is open to all Tomball residents. Service is voluntary and without monetary compensation. Any required training will be provided. Applications remain on file for two years only.

Applicants must read the **Code of Ethics** and **complete an application** and may provide a resume with the application if desired. The application form is available online at http://www.ci.tomball.tx.us/boards_commissions/index.html, from the City Secretary's office at 401 Market Street, or by calling 281-290-1002.

Once appointed, applicants must complete Open Meetings training.

Planning and Zoning Commission

Meetings - the 2nd Monday of each month at 6 p.m.

Tomball Economic Development Corporation

Meetings - usually on the 4th Tuesday in January, April, July, and October, at 5 p.m.; additional meetings may be called as needed.

Tomball Regional Authority (Hospital Board)

Meetings - the 4th Wednesday of each month at 4 p.m.

Board of Adjustments

Meetings – the 1st or 3rd Thursdays of the month, as needed, at 6 p.m.; additional meetings may be called as needed.

Tourism Advisory Committee

A special application must be completed, as this committee includes non-residents of the City. Meetings to be determined; Special sessions as called but at least once per quarter, in the evening.
