Carl Edward Brown Charged in McCoy's Kidnapping/Robbery Case

Recap of Crime

During the early morning hours of August 13, 2009, Anthony Kuss, an employee of McCoy's Building Supply Company was severely beaten, robbed, kidnapped, and left for dead – at the intersection of SH-249 and Boudreaux Road.

Charges Accepted by Harris County District Attorney's Office

On Wednesday, October 15, 2009, Detective Albert Chambers met with Chief Prosecutor Bill Exley, Harris County District Court #177 and presented additional evidence related to the Aggravated Robbery/Kidnapping case involving Mr. Kuss. The evidence presented by Detective Chambers linked Defendant Carl Brown to the theft of the shingles as well as the Robbery and Kidnapping, and as a result charges of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Felony Theft have been accepted against Defendant Carl Brown.

If convicted of the crime, Defendant Carl Brown could face 5 to 99 years in confinement and be required to pay a fine up to \$10,000.00
