Bunny Run Helps TOMAGWA & T.E.A.M.

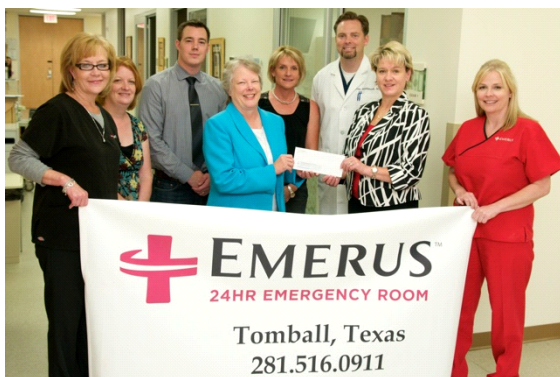
