The City of Tomball Rallies with Gulf Coast Region for 2011 Warrant Round-up

The City of Tomball will be among more than 300 law enforcement jurisdictions across Texas participating in the “2011 Great Texas Warrant Round-up”, which officially begins Saturday, March 5, 2011. Tomball will join nearly seventy other regional participants in this statewide annual event targeting people who have outstanding warrants with participating Municipal Courts.

The City of Tomball alone has thousands of active warrants it is seeking to clear. City officials encourage defendants to take advantage of one of the options available to settle outstanding warrants. However, no amnesty is being offered in conjunction with the Round-up effort.

Warrant Officer Frank Mitchell emphasized, “We are notifying defendants that there are numerous options available to assist them in quickly and conveniently taking care of their outstanding warrants without being arrested before March 5th.”

Once the warrant period begins March 5th, Tomball PD officers will aggressively target those persons on the warrant list and arrests can take place at any location, including the defendant’s home, school, or workplace.

Notices are being mailed to the last known address of defendants with active warrants pending against them. If you think you may have a warrant with the City of Tomball, and you did not receive a notice, please contact the Court for information.
